**Subject: Invitation for Participation in the “Baalpan ki Kavita – Angangi Seireng” Initiative – Revival and Compilation of Bhartiya Rhymes and Poems for Young Children.**

**No. 8/29/2021-SS/SIS(FLN):** This is notified inviting entries for the “*Baalpan ki Kavita - Angangi Seireng*”, a unique initiative launched by the Ministry of Education, Government of India with an aim to revive, preserve, and celebrate the rich tradition of Bharatiya rhymes and poems for young children by curating a joyful and culturally rooted collection to support foundational stage education.

2. The initiative focuses on compiling both traditional and original rhymes and poems in various Bhartiya Bhashas (Indian languages) including Manipuri and English, reflecting India’s diverse linguistic and cultural heritage. The objective is to nurture imagination, joy, and identity among early learners (ages 3–8) through this creative endeavour.
  3. In collaboration with *MyGov*, submissions are invited under the following categories:
    - **Well-known traditional rhymes** (with due credit to original authors, where applicable)
    - **Newly composed original rhymes and poems**
- Rhymes/ poems targeted for the following Age group of Children:**
- Pre-primary (Ages 3–6)
  - Grade 1 (Ages 6–7)
  - Grade 2 (Ages 7–8)
4. Entries may be submitted in any of the 22 Indian languages including Manipuri or English. Content must be culturally rich and age-appropriate. There is **no entry fee**. Selected entries, as per the recommendations of the Selection Committee, will receive a **Certificate of Contribution** and an **appropriate Cash Award**.
  5. **Last date for submission is 30th June 2025.** Submissions should be made via the *MyGov* portal: <https://www.mygov.in>. The contest is open to all age groups - *Students, homemakers, working professionals, entrepreneurs, and all creative individuals*.

**Categories of Submission and Terms & Conditions**

**"Baalpan ki Kavita initiative: Restoring Bhartiya rhymes/poems for young children", Manipur.**

**CATEGORIES OF SUBMISSION**

1. The rhymes/poems can be about nature, animals, birds, festivals, family, community helpers, seasons, water, food, health and hygiene transport, everyday life, patriotism, plays/games/sports etc.
2. Rhymes/poems should be joyful, interesting, easy to recite and engaging.
3. Rhymes/poems can be for following age group:
  - Pre-school/Balvatika - (3-6 years)
  - Grade 1- (6-7 years)
  - Grade 2- (7-8 years)
4. The length of the rhymes/poems should be 30-100 words in 4-12 lines which are easy to learn.
5. The rhymes/poems can be originally written, popular in local culture or folk lore or written by someone else. If written by someone else, the sender may give credit.
6. Selected rhymes/poems will be featured on NCERT/DoSE&L/MyGov/ KVS/NVS/CBSE/SCERTs platforms and other educational portals, benefiting early learners and educators nationwide.

**TERMS & CONDITIONS**

1. Participants can take part in the contest by registering on MyGov Innovate India (<https://innovateindia.mygov.in/>).
2. There is no entry fee to participate in the contest.
3. If participant is participating in the activity first time, he/she needs to fill the required details for participation on MyGov. By submitting the details and participating in the challenge, participants can be contacted if selected.
4. All the participants to ensure that his/her MyGov profile is accurate and updated since this profile shall be used for further communication. This includes details such as name, e-mail id and mobile number.
5. Submissions beyond the last date and time of submission shall not be considered.
6. The entry must not contain any provocative, objectionable, or inappropriate content.
7. The Department of School Education and Literacy (DoSE&L), Ministry of Education (MoE) has the right to cancel or amend all or any part of this Contest and/ or the Terms & Conditions/ Technical Parameters/Evaluation Criteria.
8. All submissions would be vetted by Committees/Experts to ensure high educational standards and appropriateness.
9. Any changes to the Terms & Conditions/ Technical Parameters/ Evaluation Criteria, or cancellation of the Contest, will be updated/posted on the MyGov platform. It would be the responsibility of the participants/applicants to keep themselves informed about any changes in the Terms & Conditions/ Technical Parameters/ Evaluation Criteria stated for this contest.

10. The winners will be selected by a committee and declared via winner announcement on <https://blog.mygov.in/>.
11. There will be no notification to participants of entries who are not selected as winners.

The Government of India does not bear any responsibility for copyright violations or infringements of intellectual property carried out by the participants.
13. The decision of the Selection Committee would be final and binding on all the contestants and no clarifications would be issued to any participants on any decision of the Selection Committee.
14. If it is an existing rhyme/poem, then the name of the author may be mentioned.
15. Bank details will be required to be submitted by the winners after the announcement of the result of the competition. Non-furnishing of the above information/documents at the appropriate stage will render the selection null and void.
16. Prize money will be transferred only through electronic transfer as per the bank details submitted by the winner via email.
17. Organizers will not accept any responsibility for entries that are lost, are late or incomplete or have not been transmitted due to computer error or any other error beyond the organizer's reasonable control. Proof of submission of the entry is not proof of receipt of the same.
18. The organizers reserve the right to disqualify participants, refuse/discard entries if the information submitted is plagiarized, false or erroneous.
19. All disputes/ legal complaints are subject to the jurisdiction of Delhi only. Expenses incurred for this purpose will be borne by the parties themselves.
